The blue and white monochrome decoration probably suggests it's from the Bassono region of northern Italy which suggests probably 18th century, TBV, and possibly into the early 19th century. A superb example of early Italian apothecary jar, highly sought after and prized pieces. A hand made earthenware jar, hand painted and showing a 19th century staple repair to the top rim/edge. This style of repair is certainly 19th century. The remaining areas of the jar are in mostly excellent condition with some crazing to the tin glaze surface.
