Elegant antique Vienna regulator wall clock dating to the late 19th century Circa 1890 and 7 day movement on a striking mechanism Maker - AG Lenzkirch clock makers from Scholte, Austria The clock is housed in a beautifully figured walnut veneered case with a long glazed door revealing the brass pendulum.
