Elegant antique late Regency mahogany drum table featuring a circular top with a beautifully figured mahogany surface and a finely carved rope-twist moulded edge. Circa 1820. Bought from a private house sale in London's Mayfair. The frieze is fitted with drawers and opposing dummy drawers with turned wooden handles, a traditional feature of drum tables designed for use in the centre of a room. The table stands on a substantial turned central pedestal raised on four shaped sabre legs terminating in small bun feet, providing a stable and well-balanced form. Drum tables of this type became popular during the Regency period in the early 19th century, designed as versatile writing or library tables that allowed seating from all sides. A practical and highly decorative piece, ideal for use as a library table, centre table, or statement desk in a study or living room. Offered in great shape.
