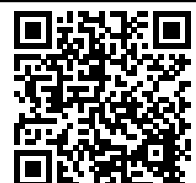
Description

Mixed media drawing of a man facing railings after Laurence Stephen Lowry (1887-1976). The drawing is signed LS Lowry and mounted in a wooden frame, gilt slip and glass. Lowry painted scenes of life in the industrial districts of North West England in the mid-20th century. He developed a distinctive style of painting and is best known for his urban landscapes peopled with human figures, often referred to as "matchstick men". He also painted mysterious unpopulated landscapes, brooding portraits and the unpublished "marionette" works, which were only found after his death. He was fascinated by the sea, and painted pure seascapes, depicting only sea and sky, from the early 1940s. He is a highly acclaimed artist. Dimensions - 30 x 24 x 6 cm
