The chairs stand on turned legs united by square stretchers and terminating in bun feet, with a wonderfully decorative, country-house feel. All the leather is original, in excellent condition, and retains a rich, supple appearance. The oak frames display striking grain, warm colour and a pleasing, mellow patina, the whole set in very good original order with no damage or repairs.
