This fascinating and very useful photographic aid was patented on the 12th of May, 1922 by the French inventor and amateur photographer, Auguste-Robert Kauffman. The leaflet accompanying the Posograph is annotated below and provides a good description of the instrument, it also comes complete with its original black leather case which is stamped to the front with "Le Posographe" and the English retailer's mark provided in gilt lettering on the inside of the lid.
