The figuring is both dramatic and refined, with deep tones and movement in the grain that give the piece real presence. It is the sort of top that immediately draws attention and elevates the entire table. The table stands on a substantial turned central pedestal, terminating in a platform base with finely carved scroll feet. This classic William IV form provides both stability and elegance, while allowing uninterrupted seating around the table. Circular dining tables such as this were designed to create a more sociable dining experience, allowing all guests to face one another comfortably. Today, these smaller circular dining tables are very usable in modern homes, working equally well as a dining table, centre table or statement piece in a hallway or living space.
