A Very Good Quality Early 19th Century, George III Period, Mahogany Baby Pembroke Type Lamp Table, Having Extremely Well Figured Drop Flap Top, With Attractive Crossbanded Decoration, Over Two Frieze Drawers to Front & Two False Frieze Drawers To Reverse, With Replacement Turned Brass Handles And Banded Decoration, Raised On Elegant Turned Central Column And Four Splayed Legs, With Further Banded Decoration And Original Brass Castors. Pembroke tables in their full size form quickly became one of the most popular pieces of furniture around the homes of the mid 18th century onwards, mainly due to their huge versatility and the plethora of different spaces which they can be situated in. In fact George Hepplewhite himself described pembroke tables as the most useful of tables and there are many references to them in 18th and 19th century literature, with Jane Austen herself even describing them being used in various different ways. It is absolutely certain that they are just as incredibly versatile for use in today's world as they were in 18th century England. The ability of being able to use the two flaps to create significant variation with the size of the table top is ver...
