Description

This large and decorative example dates to the mid 19th century. It is cast in plaster with good detail and has an old painted marble surface that incorporates interesting, soft tones and patina. It is impressive in scale and would look stunning in any home or interior. The original sculpture from which this reduction was taken is in the Louvre in Paris. It was excavated in 1792 on Prince Borghese's property, Gabil, outside Rome. The statue is attributed to the Greek artist, Praxiteles and is since referred to as Dianna De Gabies, also known as Dianna Robing, the goddess of the hunt, the moon and birthing.
