The satinwood throughout displays a warm, mellow tone, enhanced by finely executed floral swags and neoclassical detailing. Knee Height 63cm Below, the writing surface opens to reveal a leather inset slope, providing a practical and attractive writing area, while the frieze drawer is decorated with hand-painted garlands and fitted with original handles. The whole stands on slender tapering legs, also embellished with delicate painted decoration, giving the piece a light and graceful presence.

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
