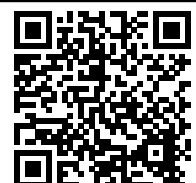

Will', marked Vernon, 28 North Audley St, London', bearing label to reverse 'Stephanie Hoppen, The British Antique Dealers Association', in ebonised wooden frame (approx 30cm x 47cm) The top of the drawing contains inscriptions that describe the cabinet's purpose and the manufacturer or designer. Referencing "Liquor Cabinet" and "Maison Krieger," the well known French furniture-making firm known for high-quality craftsmanship in the C19th and early C20th. The piece may have been an archival record from the renowned furniture maker. Condition: A detail of loss to frame bottom left, some creasing and fading.
