The Foot The glass stands on a substantial Domed Foot, which adds significant height and elegance to the profile. The underside features a genuine rough, snapped pontil mark, indicative of traditional 18th-century hand-blown techniques. This weight, combined with its superior transparency, suggests a piece of "Heavy Balustroid" influence, designed for both luxury and durability.
