This is to my mind one of the best preserved George II Scottish silver teapots. The engraved decoration is crisp and not over polished, the lid shuts well. The pot sits firmly on the single spreading foot and there are very crisp hallmarks under the base. Overall the teapot is in excellent condition with no damage.
