Description

James Shoolbred & Co. were a famous and well-regarded firm of furniture makers and furnishers with headquarters with large headquarters in the Tottenham Court Road and subsidiary shops in Grafton Street and University Street. This hall rack is an example of their most recognisable 'Art Furniture' style, possibly designed by H.W Batley. The hall rack was presumably designed to compliment Shoolbred's stick stand and hall bench, but is a rarer find than either.
