A rare Flight & Barr Worcester Porcelain Pot Pourri Vase c.1805. The flared shape vase, raised on a round fixed base, each side with two fixed gilt lions-head handles, superbly and richly decorated in Japan style with flowers, birds and bridges, in fenced gardens, within blue and gilt trellis borders, with iron red and gilt flower head medallions and stiff leaves. Incised letter 'B'. A variation of this pattern, bearing the crest and feathers of the Prince of Wales, made circa 1807, is illustrated in Henry Sandon, Flight and Barr Worcester Porcelain 1783-1840, p. 19. Condition: Excellent with no damage or restoration
