Description

A good original example of a Prussian steel Pickelhaube Helmet, dating from the First World War period, circa 1915–1918. This example retains its correct brass spike, base, rear spine, and Prussian eagle plate with “FR” cypher and motto scroll, all consistent with known wartime production. The steel skull reflects the material substitutions adopted during the later war years, and is less commonly encountered & rarer than earlier leather examples. The helmet retains its original form with visible service wear to the shell and fittings, alongside a worn but period leather liner. Overall, a scarce wartime variant of the classic Prussian pickelhaube, presenting well and consistent with late-war manufacture.
