The pair of round landscapes is framed in ornate gilded frames and painted in muted, natural colours with soft light that emphasizes balance, calmness, and the beauty of nature. Knaresborough Castle has tall trees on one side, framing the view and a calm body of water that stretches into the distance, with mountains. Bootburn Bridge, Herts, shows a tranquil landscape with water, a prominent tree stands near the centre or slightly to one side, acting as a focal point.
