The glass transitions with gentle movement from green at the base, through soft pink where land meets sky, and into cool grey tones above, creating depth and atmospheric nuance. 6824 ABOUT Daum's unique technique common to all was that a clear vessel was blown with colour only on the inner surface or layer. An acid resist landscape was painted free-hand onto the vessel which was then etched by plunging into a hydrofluoric acid bath. The outer surface was then polished which gave the trees a 'third dimension' as the onlooker can see through the clear glass to the inner colo...
