Finely carved with a tall cresting rail in a stylised foliate design, the back panel with a carved lozenge highlighted with 'Yorkshire' flying ribbons. Original timbers and pegs throughout, original seat boards. Excellent colour and condition. Front legs with small addition/re-tipped. The chair is large, capacious, comfortable and has a truly excellent rich and naturally developed colour and patination. Robust, heavy, usable and original. From a private 15th Century manor estate in Salehurst, East Sussex. Dimensions are: 43.5 inches high, 17 inches deep, 23.5 inches wide. Width between the arms is 21 inches, height of seat from floor is 19.75 inches. Depth of seat from front edge to back is 15 inches, height of back from seat is 26.25 inches.
