He Numbered some of his Clocks. Attractive Oak Case with Mahogany Crossbanding Inlay Decorations. The Hood with Mahogany Turned Columns, Topped by 3 Eagles on Ball Finials. All Raised on Bracket Feet. Height 82 inches (6 ft 10 inches) or 208.5 cm. So of a Convenient Small Proportion being Under 7 Foot.
