There is a vacant cartouche at the front which of course could be engraved by your silversmith should you wish to personalize it. The silver is hallmarked (rubbed but legible) for London 1904, the makers initials are also present, R.S. for the silversmith, for Robert Stebbings. The ring comes with a box, from a Johannesburg silversmith. Excellent condition, the ring measures 1 1/4" thick with a diameter measuring 1 7/8".
