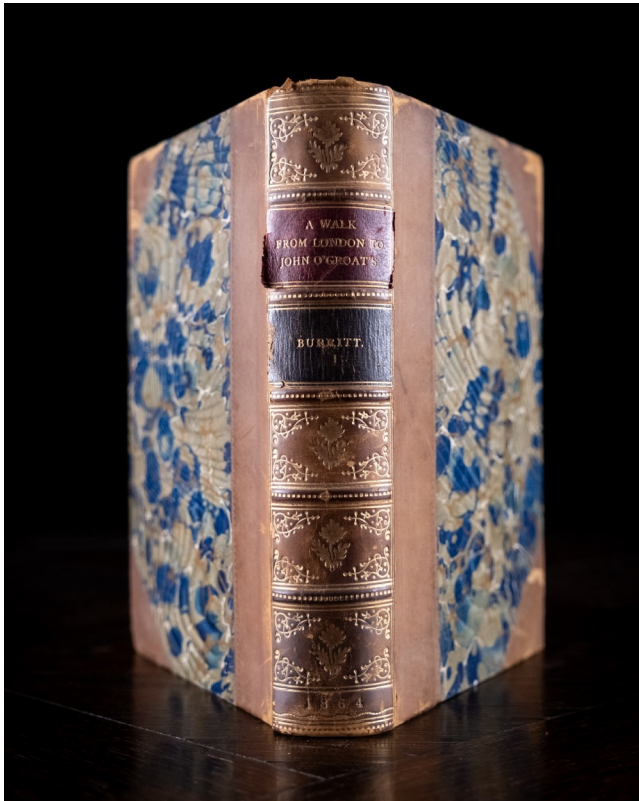

SYNOPSIS Elihu Burritt (1810-1879) was an American diplomat, philanthropist and social activist. Burritt walked from London to the northern tip of Scotland, taking extensive notes on agriculture, scenery, and the people he met along the way. The book was written to provide American readers with a detailed, intimate look at the British countryside during the 19th century.
