The constellations are depicted on lithographed paper segments; one bears the inscription: NAVISPHERE DE MR De MAGNAC Bte S.G.D.G. G. THOMAS CONSTR PARIS. The freely rotating globe is fitted in its original mahogany case. It features a horizon ring made of engraved brass with cardinal points and 4 x 90° divisions, and an attachable brass semicircle with degree divisions.
