Description

Description A fine early 19th century George III English Glass Rummer. It has a large ovoid bowl above a capstan stem. Solid conical, stepped, foot with snapped pontil. Historical Context Capstan were introduced in c1800. On Rummors and Ales, the stems at that early time were quite thin (around the same thickness as a standard plain stem from the mid 18th century), however, as the century progresses, the stems become progressively thicker and by the time we get to the early 20th century examples, when they were still used as a stem, they can be more than twice as thick and quite clumsy in comparison.
