A robust metal swing handle liner completes the piece, balancing practicality with decorative appeal. Originally made for domestic use, it now serves beautifully as a fireside accessory, planter, or decorative storage vessel. The warm timber tones paired with the gleam of brass give it a timeless quality that suits both traditional and contemporary interiors. A particularly well-preserved example of 19th-century craftsmanship.
