Size: 4ft 3in x 1ft 7in (180 x 48cm) face size. Antique Saryk Turkmen torba face with 'kedjebe' design. Circa 1880. A good torba face with a very well drawn example of the 'kedjebe' design, with excellent colour and good wool. These torba were used to decorate the side of a camel during a Turkmen wedding procession, these were prized possessions and formed part of the wedding dowry. They were kept as heirlooms and displayed inside the yurt. This example is of firm, tight weave, with depressed warps giving a ridged back and a pelt like handle. The design is associated with weddings. The torba is in excellent condition with very slight wear and good pile. The back has been removed at some time in the past. Stock Number: D-2472.
