Condition: No obvious damage or repair just minor age related wear to surface and to hallmarks Silver berry spoons, characterized by embossed bowls featuring fruit or floral designs, became popular in the mid-19th century Victorian era as specialized serving utensils. While associated with the 18th century, most are earlier plain Georgian spoons, later "updated" with ornate decoration during the Victorian period. Often gilded, they protected silver from acidic fruit juices
