Elliott Ltd, based in Croydon, London, played a significant role in the British war effort during World War II, producing specialized clocks for the military, particularly the Royal Air Force along with aircraft parts. The case inner has a label marked 'North Weald' which was a vital RAF station in WW2. It was home to 11 group which were the first fighter command group.
