Iconic Regency mahogany hall bench / seat, attributed to Marsh and Tatham; untouched condition having an excellent rich colour and patina; the well figured solid mahogany seat with an inset reeded moulding, having rounded scrolled ends, repeating the reeded moulding, flanked with carved roundel paterae; raised on fluted tapering rectangular legs, headed with waisted collars and terminating in panelled spade feet. Having the unusual feature of being finished identical on both sides so can be used free standing. English circa 1810 Good original condition Dimensions (ins) 42 wide x 19.25 high x 15.25 deep From a design by Charles Heathcote Tatham (1772 - 1842) who was inspired by a Roman classical marble seat. See Plate XIII of his publication "Etchings Representing the Best Examples of Ancient Ornamental Architecture (1799)" Marsh and Tatham were active in London from the late 18th century until the 1820s, Marsh and Tatham were among the most important cabinetmakers of the Regency period. Operating from Mount Street, Mayfair, the firm was led by Thomas Marsh and later joined by Charles Tatham, whose partnership flourished in the Regency era. They held Royal appointment...
