This finely executed 19th Century silver articulated fish spice box dates circa 1880. Realistically modelled in the form of a fish with an articulated body and standing on fins, allowing the position to be upright or laying flat. The hinged cover is the head and has a hook fastening. These spice boxes were usually copies of a Georgian English design and were around the 1880s. Generally used as spice containers, they may also have been used by some gentlemen for storing their snuff. They are rather scarce and hence command high prices. Hallmarks: Unmarked but tested as silver. Condition: Very good condition. Hinge secure and strong.. No repairs. Articulated body works smoothly. Fish stands nicely on its fins. Fins undamaged.
