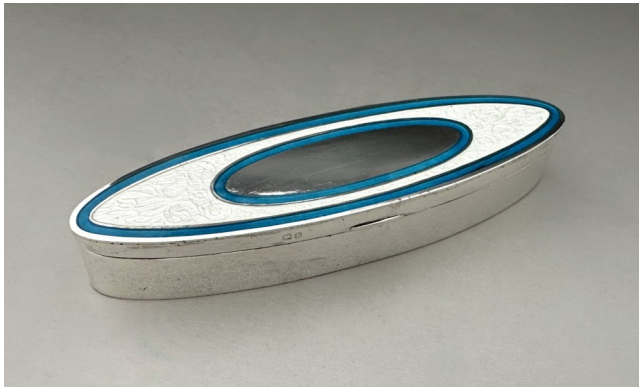

To the centre is a silver oval cartouche, which is free from engraving. With the lid open, the gilded interior is revealed along with a blue velvet lining to the inside of the lid.
