The bell makes the most wonderful sound when used, the heavy clapper made of solid silver. A really superb and highly collectible bell in excellent condition, the bell has a diameter measuring 2 7/8" and stands 4" tall. The bell is weighty, coming in at 160 Grams or 5.14 Troy Ounces.
