This is a beautiful German WMF Art Nouveau silver-plated visiting card tray fruit dish, circa 1900 in date. Depicting a female figure in a long, flowing diaphanous dress, the train forming the double-sided tray, marked to the underside with 'AS' for antique silver finish, 'B' for Britannia metal and 'I/O' for normal thickness silver plate, along with the WMF ostrich mark. This exquisite casket could house anything from trinkets, keys, sweets to jewellery. Whatever you choose to use this item for you are sure to do it in style. WMF In 1853, Daniel Straub, a miller from Geislingen, joined forces with the Schweizer Brothers to form the "Metallwarenfabrik Straub & Schweizer" in Geislingen. This was the second company to be founded by Straub - previously in 1850, from the nucleus of a small repair workshop, which he had set up to work on the construction of Geislingen's famous railway incline, he had founded Maschinenf...
