An 8-day duration precision English fusee mechanism no. 12557 by F.W. Elliott in 1939. F.W. Elliott Ltd, based in Croydon, London, played a significant role in the British war effort during World War II, producing specialized clocks for the military, particularly the Royal Air Force along with aircraft parts.
