The oak throughout has developed a rich, natural patina that enhances the sculptural carving. Complete, matched sets of this type — especially those retaining the original stools — are exceptionally scarce. The unified carving, cohesive form and strong visual presence make this a standout decorative ensemble with real interior-design appeal.
