Size: 4ft 5in x 2ft 7in (135 x 79cm). Antique Tekke Turkmen chuval face with six 'Salor' turreted guls. Circa 1900. Chuval are storage bags used by the Turkmen nomads for the storage of personal items inside the yurt and also for the transport of goods on the backs of camels or horses. They were usually woven in pairs. The chuval face is drawn with six 'Salor' guls and Tekke chuval guls as secondary guls. The extensive use of cochineal dye gives the superb rich ground colour. The elem panel at the base is of a Turkmen shrub design. At some time in its history the plain weave back has been removed, making this very suitable for use as a small rug. Good condition with slight even wear and good pile, there is a small old repair in the top right hand corner, this is reflected in the price. Stock Number: D-0523.
