This is an impressive antique George III flame mahogany, satin wood banded, boxwood and ebony strung breakfront wardrobe circa 1780 in date. The wardrobe has strong architectural lines and features an elegant moulded cornice above two cupboard doors enclosing three mahogany sliding trays. This is above a lower section which features two half width over two full width oak-lined hand dovetailed drawers fitted with brass oval backplate handles. The central section is flanked by cupboards each enclosing full length hanging space and the wardrobe is raised on an elegant shaped plinth with moulded bracket feet. It comes complete with working locks and key. It is a truly beautiful wardrobe which is also very spacious.
