A Really Gorgeous Antique Silver Plated Spoon Warmer made in the form of a nautilus shell on an ornate coral-style stand. The shell body is engraved with flowing, wave-like lines that accentuate the spiral form and add a lively surface pattern. A curled side element acts as a stylised handle made of coral, completing the marine-inspired silhouette. The purpose of the piece is to keep serving spoons warm at the table, helping sauces and gravies stay fluid during service. A hinged lid is fitted to the top section, allowing the warmed interior space to be accessed neatly during use – circa 1860. * A spoon warmer is one of those refined table accessories that speaks quietly of formal dining and careful service. Measurements: Height: 4 3/4" (approx. 12cm) Width of base: 7 3/4" (approx. 19.5cm) Depth of base: 3 1/2" (approx. 9cm) Total weight: 506g In good condition – The silver plate shows only light surface wear consistent with age and gentle handling.
