This elegant Georgian Rosewood tea caddy, dating to circa 1820, represents the height of Regency domestic sophistication. Constructed in the classic sarcophagus form, the piece is veneered in beautifully figured Rosewood, featuring a striking grain that wraps seamlessly around the tapered body and chamfered lid. The exterior is further elevated by delicate Boxwood stringing and retains its original French polished finish, which has developed a rich, deep patination over the last two centuries. The caddy is adorned with its original cast brass lion mask ring handles to the sides, a quintessential Regency motif that adds a sense of stately character. Upon opening the lid, the interior reveals a well-appointed three-compartment arrangement. It contains two removable tea canisters with matching Rosewood lids and Boxwood edging, flanking a central aperture. This central well houses a replacement cut-glass mixing bowl, traditionally used for blending different tea leaves or holding sugar, which fits within the circular recess. The underside of the lid retains a vibrant red ...
