The interior has been professionally relined in a quality hand marbelled paper, perfectly in keeping creating a very usable clean finish. There is a removable tray too, which has at some time been painted white on the exterior, and again finished with the same paper. Perfect for a lady or gentleman, as useful as beautiful .. for jewellery, watches, cufflinks, desk paraphernalia or cherished photographs. Standing on four turned bun feet, the box is in beautiful condition, with a footprint measuring 10" x 7 1/2" and stands approximately 6".
