Description

A striking late 19th-century carved oak table in excellent antique condition. The rectangular top sits above a deeply carved frieze, decorated with scrolling foliage and bold lion-mask corner mounts. The table stands on impressive barley-twist legs, each one crisply turned and terminating in carved paw feet. A shaped stretcher unites the legs, adding both stability and a pleasing sense of balance to the design. The twin drawers are housed in the frieze, each fitted with a central keyhole and offering useful storage. The oak has developed a warm, even colour with a lovely sheen, highlighting the quality of the carving and the craftsmanship throughout.
