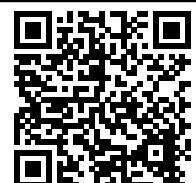
A fabulous and rare find. This medical travel set is made from solid English silver and made by the top notch London silversmith / luxury retailer, Drew & Sons of Piccadilly Circus. The set looks to never have been used with the interior retaining it's pristine lavishly gilded finish. The top is removed and in turn separates in two to reveal a double compartment pill box, finished in gold and hallmarked. Inside the canister an inverted funnel is revealed inside a glass medicine glass with measurements engraved on the side. All pieces of silver are hallmarked for London 1903, an Edwardian example, together with the makers mark for Drew & Sons (Samuel Summers Drew & Ernest Drew). The underside of the outer canister is also signed by the retailer. A superb, highly collectable piece of English silver measuring 2" in diameter x 2 3/4" tall and weighing 161.5 Grams / 5.19 Troy Ounces including glass. Excellent condition. Drew and Sons began trading in 1844, as proudly noted on their letterhead. Like many firms of the nineteenth century who catered to the needs of the travelling gentleman, they started out supplying luggage and travel requisites before expanding into po...
