The bench retains its original paint with a beautifully weathered patina, showcasing the craftsmanship and durability that have made Arras pieces so collectible. Arras garden furniture takes its name from the historic town of Arras, in northern France - a centre of ironwork craftsmanship during the 19th century. The Grassin-Baledans Factory, also known as the Arras Foundry, was one of three primary metal product manufacturers in the town and became known for its distinctive, high-end wrought iron garden furniture and artistic ironwork.
