An antique nine men's morris game complete with pegs, which can be stored in the drawer below. It is made from oak, with a drawer with a turned knob. Probably originated from a pub. Nine Men's Morris is an ancient two-player strategy board game dating back to the Roman Empire, where players aim to form "mills" (three pegs in a row) to remove opponent pieces. With 9 pieces each, players aim to reduce the opponent to two pieces or block all their moves. The game measures 24cm w x 24cm d x 6cm h.
