The original convex painted Roman dial signed Desbois & Wheeler, Gray's Inn Passage, retaining its original surface with attractive age-related craquelure, fitted with original style steel hands and strike/silent selection to the arch. The substantial twin fusee eight-day movement striking the hours on a bell, additionally fitted with pull repeat and engraved backplate signed by the maker. The clock remains in good working order.
