A high quality 8-day duration, 5 pillar mechanism striking the hours on a bell. Original brass cased weights. Circa 1795. Kenneth McLennan of London was a highly talented maker and made a planetarium for The Royal Institution in 1801. A bracket clock is also in the Weatherfield collection. He worked 1776-1825.
