Édouard Drouot (3 April 1859 – 22 May 1945) was a French sculptor who was a student of Emile Thomas and Mathurin Moreau at the Beaux-Arts de Paris and a member of the Salon des Artistes Français. He is best known for his bronze and marble sculptures of allegorical and mythological scenes that are characterized by a sense of movement and expressive touch.
