Description

I know I often say this about various items I buy.....but forgive me for repeating myself....again one of the best 17thc Bellarmine Jugs, I have bought in 30 years of dealing...it stands an impressive 15.50" inches high (39.4cms) with a width and depth of 9.00" inches (23cms)...made from stoneware with a desirable "tiger glaze" and is in perfect condition...remarkable when you consider its age..! These collectable items were used to export wine to Europe, England and many more countries in the 17thc from Rhenish in Germany and usually when the wine was drunk and the bellarmine emptied it would have been broken up or thrown in the river....you do find a lot of broken bellarmine shards on the Thames foreshore....the bellarmine is in original condition with no restoration and is decorated with a moulded bearded mask above three roundels with flower heads in...a wonderful item to own albeit for a short time...! German. C1640 -50.
