Supports adorned with cast finials, prominent in form for use as boot pulls. Extra wide scraper bar useful for riding boots and shoes - 23cm (9"). Substantial weight of 14.8kg (32.6 lb) - ideal for stable and enduring use. Pair of mounting holes to the base for secure placement at an entranceway. Maker's mark to base for A. Kenrick & Sons, with serial number and registered design number. Combines practical function with townhouse elegance, perfectly suited for period properties.
