Leading example of the prolific Czech born, Vienna trained still life painted depicting a large scale study of freshly picked flowers arranged in a glass vase upon a table in an interior. **KONSTANTIN STOITZNER (1863-1934)** Signed BIOGRAPHY Konstantin Stoitzner was an Austrian painter. The son of the botanist and teacher Karl Stoitzner, he studied at the Vienna Academy of Fine Arts under August Eisenmenger and Christian Griepenkerl. He created oil paintings with genre scenes, portraits and still life. From 1900 he mainly devoted himself to landscape painting with motifs from the Alps, Burgenland, Moravia, East Frisia and the Luneburg Heath.
